The Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) staff is providing a speaker to Reading High School students participating in the Reading Works program.

Reading Works is a pre-apprentice program that recruits, prepares and connects Reading High School youth to craft union apprentice programs and contractors who will be part of the renovation of Reading's wastewater collection and treatment system and other construction sites in the Reading-Berks area.
