Call to Order

Mr. Brown called the meeting to order at 6:34 pm. He noted that a quorum was present.

Due to Mr. Carroll's and Mr. Rosado's absence, Ms. Smith suggested that all business except the review of the permit application for more than six dogs / cats be deferred until the April meeting. The Board agreed.

New Business

- **1733 Pear St** – more than six dogs / cats

Ms. Baller reviewed the application form. She stated that she began working with Ms. Spayd in December 2022. She stated that all the animals are up-to-date on their vaccinations and have been spayed / neutered. She stated that Ms. Spayd is a homeowner and the home passed the ARL inspection. She stated that everything is orderly and the animals are healthy. She stated that she is confident that Ms. Spayd will properly care for the animals.

Mr. Straub questioned if all the felines had leukemia. Ms. Baller stated that they do not. She stated that some of the cats were rescues and others were found in the neighborhood but that none of the animals have tested positive.

Mr. Straub commended those who adopt sick animals. He noted his support for the approval of this permit.

Mr. Straub moved, seconded by Mr. Brown, to approve the permit for more than six dogs / cats at 1733 Pear St. Motion carried unanimously.

Other Matters

Ms. Baller questioned if additional permits were received by the City. Mr. Reed stated that no additional permit applications have been received.

The Board will meet in April 2023. Ms. Smith was asked to poll members closer to the meeting date for member's availability. The meeting will be virtual.
