The quarterly meeting of the City of Reading Electricians Examining Board was convened in the 3rd Floor Conference Rm, City Hall, on Monday, August 26, 2019, as mandated by the City of Reading Ordinance #98-2006/78-2009, at 4:30 PM.

A Motion was made by Todd Rathman, second by Mark Pinkasavage, to approve the minutes of the June 3, 2019 regular meeting. Motion Passed

The Electrical Inspector reported that the July 8, 2019 exam results were as follows:

Master Electrician – 1 Fail

Journeyman Electrician – 4 Pass, 17 Fail

A Discussion was held regarding the migration of certain “electrical” work to other trades due to the pre-fabricated nature of certain electrical lighting products. This is of concern, but not specifically addressed in the National Electrical Code. The Electrical Inspector noted that “Plug and Play” electrical equipment is not regulated in the Electrical Code, and is specifically exempted by the PA UCC. No solution was offered, and additional information will be required for action.
