- 2.01 Bidder accepts all of the terms and conditions of the advertisement or invitation to bid and instructions to bidders, including without limitation those dealing with the disposition of bid security. The bid will remain subject to acceptance for 90 days after the bid opening, or for such longer period of time that bidder may agree to in writing upon request of owner.

ARTICLE 3 BIDDER’S REPRESENTATIONS

- 3.01 In submitting this Bid, Bidder represents, as set forth in the Agreement, that:
 - A. Bidder has examined and carefully studied the Bidding Documents, the other related data identified in the Bidding Documents, and the following Addenda, receipt of all which is hereby acknowledged.

- B. Bidder has visited the Site and become familiar with and is satisfied as to the general, local and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.

- C. Bidder is familiar with and is satisfied as to all federal, state and local Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress and performance of the Work.
- D. Bidder has carefully studied all: (1) reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or contiguous to the Site and all drawings of physical conditions in or relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at or contiguous to the Site (except Underground Facilities) which have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions as provided in paragraph 4.03 of the General Conditions, and (2) reports and drawings of a Hazardous Environmental Condition, if any, which has been identified in the Supplementary Conditions as provided in paragraph 4.05 of the General Conditions.
- E. Bidder has obtained and carefully studied (or assumes responsibility for having done so) all additional or supplementary examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies and data concerning conditions (surface, subsurface and Underground Facilities) at or contiguous to the Site which may affect cost, progress, or performance of the Work or which relate to any aspect of the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Bidder, including applying the specific means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction expressly required by the Bidding Documents to be employed by Bidder, and safety precautions and programs incident thereto.
- F. Bidder does not consider that any further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the determination of this Bid for performance of the Work at the price(s) bid and within the times and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.
- G. Bidder is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by OWNER and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.
- H. Bidder has correlated the information known to Bidder, information and observations obtained from visits to the Site, reports and drawings identified in the Bidding Documents, and all additional examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, and data with the Bidding Documents.
- I. Bidder has given ENGINEER written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and the written resolution thereof by ENGINEER is acceptable to Bidder.
- J. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for the performance of the Work for which this Bid is submitted.
- K. No officer, agent, or employee of the OWNER is personally interested, directly or indirectly, in this Bid and accompanying Contract or the compensation to be paid hereunder.

L. This Bid is made without connection with any person, firm, or corporation making a Bid for the same work, and is, in all respects, fair and without collusion or fraud.

3.02 Bidder further represents that this Bid is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed individual or entity and is not submitted in conformity with any agreement or rules of any group, association, organization or corporation; Bidder has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other Bidder to submit a false or sham Bid; Bidder has not solicited or induced any individual or entity to refrain from bidding; and Bidder has not sought by collusion to obtain for itself any advantage over any other Bidder or over OWNER.

4.01 The undersigned Bidder offers to furnish all labor, superintendence, materials, supplies, equipment, plant and other facilities, utilities and all things necessary or proper for, and to perform all Work (as defined in the General Conditions) necessary or incidental to the above stated Project, complete in every respect, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents (as defined in the General Conditions) and any future changes therein as provided in the Project Manual, and to perform all other obligations imposed by the Contract Documents for the Prices named in the following schedule:

- D. Other additional and extra work, if any, performed in accordance with the Contract shall be paid for as provided in the Specifications.

ARTICLE 5 TIME OF COMPLETION

- 5.01 Bidder agrees that the Work will be substantially completed, and completed and ready for final payment on or before the dates or within the number of calendar days indicated in the Agreement.
- 5.02 Bidder accepts the provisions of the Agreement as to liquidated damages in the event of failure to complete the Work within the times specified above, which shall be stated in the Agreement.

ARTICLE 6 BID EXECUTION

- 6.01 The undersigned Bidder hereby represents that should this Bid, including any combination of alternates, additions, deductions or omissions indicated or authorized by the Schedule of Prices be accepted by the OWNER within 90 days of the opening of bids, Bidder will execute the Contract and furnish the properly executed bonds and

insurance certificates within the time and in the forms and amount required by the Contract Documents and that upon Bidder's failure, neglect, or refusal to do so, Bidder shall forfeit to the Owner the Bid Security accompanying this Bid, not as a penalty, but as liquidated damages.
