Notice is hereby given that on May 9, 2022 the Council of the City of Reading will consider the following substantial amendments to the PY2019 Action Plan.

To approve or deny a Council Resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute the following PY2019 Action Plan Amendments.

Amendment Number 1 - Transfer \$360,000 in CDBG-CV CARES Act funding from the Special Economic Development Activity and Microenterprise Assistance Activity to the 615 to 619 Walnut St. Veterans Housing Project. 12 housing units will be rehabilitated. The new activity's eligibility / fundability is 24 CFR § 570.202 residential rehabilitation / 24 CFR § 570.208 (a)(3) low and moderate-income level household benefit.

Amendment Number 2 - Transfer \$100,000 in CDBG-CV CARES Act funding from the Special Economic Development Activity and Microenterprise Assistance Activity to the McKnight and Spring Streets Fire Station HVAC Improvements Project. The activity's service area contains 77% low and moderate income level persons. The activity's eligibility / 24CFR570.201(c) fundability is public facilities and improvements / 24CFR570.208 (a) (1) low mod area benefit.
