Notice is hereby given that on January 13, 2025 the Council of the City of Reading will consider the following amendment to the PY2024 CDBG Action Plan.

To approve or deny a Council Resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute a PY2024 CDBG Action Plan Amendment. \$250,000 in CDBG funds will be allocated for the Demolition Low and Moderate Income Level Housing Activity. The developer is HDC Mid Atlantic. The location of the activity is 201 S. 6th St. 51% percent of the apartments must be low and moderate income level housing units. The funding will come from the existing Demolition Slum and Blight Spot Basis Activity as well as from unprogrammed CDBG funds.

The activity's eligibility / fundability is Demolition 24CFR570.201(d) / Low Mod Housing 24CFR570.208 (a) (3).
