A special meeting of the City of Reading Electricians Examining Board and Standards was convened in the 3rd Floor Conference Room, City Hall, on Monday, January 24, 2022, as allowed by the City of Reading Ordinance #98-2006/78-2009, at 4:30 PM.

Members Present: Geoffrey Litwin, Chairman, Todd Rathman, Timothy Waldman, Timothy Pelter, Mark Pinkasavage, and City of Reading Electrical Inspector, Jeffrey C. Bower – Liaison.

The purpose of this special meeting is to discuss proposed changes to the current ordinance, #98-2006 amended by #78-2009, in regards to electrical testing.

Discussion ensued regarding the changes with the following being recommended:

1. Applicants will have 1 year to take the exam from the date of Electrician's Examination Board Approval to test.
2. To be accepted test results must be dated between the date the application was received and 1 year after Electrician's Examination Board approval to test.
3. Applicant must meet the eligibility requirements set forth in the ordinance, regardless of test results, in order to receive a license.
4. The addition of a \$25 administration fee for license applications.
5. The passing score for a master exam shall be 75% or higher.
6. The passing score for a journeyman exam shall be 70% or higher.
7. Remove the 30 day limit to obtain a license after receiving test results.

A motion was made by Timothy Waldman and seconded by Timothy Pelter to recommend these changes to City Council. Vote was unanimous.

The next regular meeting will be held on March 7, 2022 at 4:30PM in the 3rd Floor Conference Room, City Hall.
