A lengthy discussion was held on the work history of apprentice Ryan Rodriguez. Ryan did not have any documented hours of service under a Master Plumber and was not indentured with the State Of Pennsylvania . It was with regrets that Ryan was not approved for the Journeyman's exam.

The following applicants were approved for the Master's exam: Brennan R Machemer, Brandon Spangler, Glen Styer and James Joseph Crockett.

James F McCoy had a retired Journeyman's license from 1994 and an incomplete work history. It was determined that he will have to retest as a Journeyman and meet the documented Journeyman's requirements prior to being eligible for approval for the Master's exam.
