The Electrical Inspector reported that the October 5, 2009 exam results were as follows:

Master Electrician – 1 Pass, 4 Fail

Journeyman Electrician - 7 Pass, 16 Fail

Appliance Installer – 1 Fail

The Electrical Inspector informed the Board that unless there is a last minute effort by the PA Legislature to derail the automatic adoption process, the 2008 NEC as well as all of the 2009 ICC codes will be adopted and enforced as of 1/1/2010

There has been no progress on the updating of the City of Reading Electrical Code. The Trades Division is waiting for the Legal Department to initiate this process.

The Electrical Inspector informed the Board that the ECP issue has still not been settled and an additional appeal hearing could still occur, more information will follow.
