The Electrical Inspector reported that the April 5, 2010 exam results were as follows:

**Master Electrician** – 2 Pass, 2 Fail

**Journeyman Electrician** - 3 Pass, 9 Fail

The Electrical Inspector reported that the old Berkshire Bottling Works project has been revived as the Blue Mountain Bottling Works using the same electrical contractor that was on that job from the beginning. Also the Goggle Works apartment project appears to be moving forward.

There has been some progress on the updating of the City of Reading Electrical Code. A consultant, Dave Diamantes, has been retained to evaluate the trades and fire codes to facilitate the rewriting of the amendments. The entire trades team along with fire and legal met with Mr. Diamantes last week for that purpose. We are awaiting word on the current HBA appeal of the PA adoption of the 2009 “I” codes.

The Electrical Inspector informed the Board that the ECP issue has still not been settled and an additional appeal hearing could still occur, more information will follow.

The next meeting will be held on September 13, 2010 at 4:30PM in the Zoning/Planning Conference Room, City Hall.
