The quarterly meeting of the City of Reading Electricians Examining Board and Standards was convened in room 3-10, City Hall, on Monday, September 14, 2009, as mandated by the City of Reading Ordinance #98-2006, at 4:30 PM.

The Electrical Inspector reported that the July 13, 2009 exam results were as follows:

Master Electrician – 1 Pass, 4 Fail

Journeyman Electrician - 7 Pass, 16 Fail

A letter was presented from the Con-Ed Program Coordinator of BCTC regarding allowing 4th year apprentices to take their exam in April, before the finish of the school year. The Board again restated their opposition to that. The Board insists that the existing rules be followed and that all required documents, including a certificate of completion from the 4th year, be included in a testing application. This motion was made by Ryan Helms, second by Mark Pinkasavage, with all in favor.

The Board requested that new language regarding Solar PV/Wind/Alternative Energy installations as presented to the Electrical Inspector be included in the updated Electrical Code that is currently in progress.

The Electrical Inspector informed the Board that the ECP issue has not been settled and an additional appeal hearing could still occur, more information will follow
