The quarterly meeting of the City of Reading Plumbing Board of Examiners and Standards was convened in Room 3-10 in City Hall, as mandated by the City of Reading Plumbing Ordinance at 4:00 P.M.

The board approved the minutes of the June 5<sup>th</sup> 2013 meeting.

Lemont St. James will have to re-test for the Journeyman's license.  
Amado Tinoco will have to re-test for the Master's license.

Allen Howell has not provided the required documentation and therefore is not eligible to take the Journeyman's test.

The board voted to postpone the revocation of Wes Pierre's Master Plumbing License until further review. He has not responded to registered letters for numerous violations, out standing bench warrants and failure to appear in front of the plumbing board to address these allegations. At the time that his license is revoked, he will have the opportunity to attend a meeting to address the revocation of his license.

The board discussed the declining enrolment of plumbing apprentices and its effect on the apprenticeship school program.

Brian Miller accepted the invitation to fill the vacant position on the plumbing board. He will have to go through City Council's approval process.
