The quarterly meeting of the City of Reading Plumbing Board of Examiners and Standards was convened in the Penn Room in City Hall as mandated by the City of Reading Plumbing Ordinance at 4:00 PM.

Members Present: Steve Fisher, Chip Fegley, Will Gernert, Brian Miller, and Steve Symons

Also in attendance: Jay Montgomery, City of Reading Plumbing Inspector

The minutes of the June 4th, 2014 meeting were approved.

There were two applicants for a Master Plumber's license to review.

Both Kenneth Williams and James Hoch never attended an apprenticeship school. The following eligibility requirements are required:

1. Each applicant must present 8 years of documented trades service including W2s and notarized letters from master plumbers stating the applicants work history.
2. Upon providing documented trades service each applicant will be eligible to take the journeyman's license examination.
3. Upon successfully obtaining a journeyman's license each applicant will be required to serve as a journeyman plumber under a master plumber for a period of no less than 2 years.
4. Upon providing a minimum of two years of documented service under a master plumber each applicant will be eligible to take the master plumber's examination.
