Monday, November 7, 2011
Meeting Report

Attendance: S. Marmarou, D. Reed, F. Acosta

Others Attending: S. Katzenmoyer

The meeting was called to order at 6:10 pm by Mr. Marmarou.

I. Interviews

Dan Gallagher (appointment – Redistricting Committee)

Mr. Marmarou stated that Mr. Gallagher is known by Committee members and is well liked in the community. Mr. Acosta voiced his support of Mr. Gallagher.

Mr. Gallagher stated that he attended the first meeting of the Redistricting Committee. He stated that the Committee did not have much direction. He noted that several small shifts will be needed.

Ms. Reed stated that most districts are evenly distributed. Mr. Gallagher stated that 14,600 people per district would be ideal. He stated that the Committee will work to make it as evenly distributed as possible.

Mr. Marmarou stated that Mr. Gallagher has already been participating and understands the process.

The Administrative Oversight Committee recommends the appointment of Dan Gallagher to the Redistricting Committee.

George Seidel (appointment – Blighted Property Review Committee)

Mr. Marmarou questioned why Mr. Seidel was interested in serving on this Committee. Mr. Seidel stated that he was recruited by Lee Olson. He stated that he is interested in assisting the City and that he is involved in several non-profit groups. He stated that he served on the City's

Blue Ribbon Panel and that he is not professionally trained for this Committee but that he does have experience working with the City.

The Administrative Oversight Committee recommends the appointment of George Seidel to the Blighted Property Review Committee.

David Moodhart (reappointment – Shade Tree Commission)

Mr. Marmarou questioned how residents should report problematic trees in their neighborhood. Mr. Moodhart suggested that residents call the City Arborist or the Property Maintenance office.

Mr. Marmarou questioned why Mr. Moodhart was interested in continuing to serve. Mr. Moodhart stated that he began working with the Commission in 2006 when things were not good. He stated that there has been much improvement and he is looking forward to positive change.

Mr. Marmarou questioned if this Commission was full. Ms. Katzenmoyer stated that there is one vacancy.

The Committee directed Ms. Katzenmoyer to communicate with BAC liaisons to remind them about the attendance policy.

The Administrative Oversight Committee recommends the reappointment of David Moodhart to the Shade Tree Commission.

II. Residency Requirement

Mr. Marmarou stated that he has requested that the residency issue for employees be examined in the past and expressed the belief that it should be reinstated.

Mr. Acosta voiced his support of a residency requirement for employees but noted that it may be a difficult battle. He requested Ms. Katzenmoyer draft an ordinance.

Ms. Katzenmoyer stated that residency requirement may assist residents but stated that collective bargaining issues were raised in the past.

The Administrative Oversight Committee adjourned at 6:45 pm.
