The meeting was called to order at 4:30 pm by Mr. Marmarou.

I. Interview

Troy Stricker (appointment – Stadium Commission)

Mr. Marmarou questioned why Mr. Stricker was interested in serving in this capacity. Mr. Stricker stated that he is a life-long resident of the City and attended Albright College. He stated that he does not feel that anyone has the right to push him out of his City and expressed his belief that the Reading Phillies are a bright spot of Reading. He stated that he hopes that the City will continue to be proud of this venue. He stated that he is a local business owner and wishes to get involved.

Ms. Reed questioned if Mr. Stricker lives in the City. Mr. Stricker stated that he does live in the City and also owns Sam's Goose House. He noted the need for young people to be involved in their community.

The Administrative Oversight Committee recommends the appointment of Mr. Stricker to the Stadium Commission. *Note: the appointment will be made when there is an opening on the Commission and will be based on the Mayor's formal recommendation.*
