The meeting was called to order at 4:45 pm by Mr. Marmarou.

I. Interview

Jonathan DelCollo (reappointment – Board of Ethics)

Mr. Marmarou questioned if Mr. DelCollo understood the purpose of the Board. Mr. DelCollo stated that he does as he has been serving for a number of years. He stated that the current group works well together.
