

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING 1-301 OF THE CITY OF READING CODIFIED ORDINANCES (Compensation of Elected Officials) BY AMENDING THE SALARY RANGE FOR THE MAYOR AND CITY AUDITOR.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF READING HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 1-301 of the City of Reading Codified Ordinances (Compensation of Elected Officials) shall be amended to read as follows:

From and after the first Monday of January, 2008, the following salaries shall be paid to each of the hereinafter designated elected officials of the City in accordance with the following schedule, provided however, that such salaries shall apply only to such elected officials assuming office on or after the first Monday of January, 2008:


- (a) Mayor - the Mayor of the City of Reading shall be compensated at an annual salary of ;
 - 1. \$68,100.00 for the period beginning the first Monday in January, 2008, and ending the first Sunday in January, 2009.
 - 2. \$69,600.00 for the period beginning the first Monday in January, 2009, and ending the first Sunday in January, 2010.
 - 3. \$71,100.00 for the period beginning on the first Monday in January, 2010, and ending the first Sunday in January, 2011.
 - 4. \$72,600.00 for the period beginning the first Monday in January, 2011, and annually for each year thereafter.

- (b) City Auditor - the City Auditor of the City of Reading shall be compensated at an annual salary of ;
 - 1. \$53,100.00 for the period beginning the first Monday in January, 2008, and ending the first Sunday in January, 2009.
 - 2. \$54,600.00 for the period beginning the first Monday in January, 2009, and ending the first Sunday in January, 2010.
 - 3. \$56,100.00 for the period beginning on the first Monday in January, 2010, and ending the first Sunday in January, 2011.
 - 4. \$57,600.00 for the period beginning the first Monday in January, 2011, and annually for each year thereafter.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective on January 7th, 2008.


