

BILL NO. 27 -2011

AN ORDINANCE

VACATING AND REMOVING FROM THE TOPOGRAPHICAL SURVEY OF THE CITY OF READING, A PORTION OF EASTMAN ROAD AND DURHAM STREET AS DESCRIBED IN ATTACHED EXHIBIT "A".

WHEREAS, The City of Reading deems it expedient for the public good to vacate and remove from the topographical survey of the City of Reading a portion of Eastman Road and Durham Street, Reading, Berks County, Pennsylvania,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF READING HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. As described in attached Exhibit "A" and containing in area _____ s.f.) of land, the same hereby is vacated and removed from the topographical survey of the City of Reading.

SECTION 2. The Director of the Department of Public Works, the City Engineer be and he is hereby authorized and directed to enter and record the above-described change in the topographical book of streets in the Department of Public Works.


SECTION 3. The City Solicitor is authorized and directed to take such further steps in court or elsewhere as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this Ordinance.


