AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE FIRST ADDENDUM TO THE AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION BETWEEN THE CITY OF READING AND THE READING SCHOOL DISTRICT SETTING FORTH CLARIFICATIONS TO THE ORIGINAL AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Reading and the Reading School District have formed a Reading Recreation Commission in an effort to provide a mechanism to adequately and efficiently maintain community recreation services and facilities and to organize, manage and supervise recreational and educational programs, with a primary focus and emphasis on programs for youth, within the political boundaries of the City and the School District; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to clarify language in the original Agreement; and

NOW, THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF READING HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to execute the attached First Addendum to the Agreement of Cooperation between the City and the School District.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be effective ten (10) days after passage.



FIRST ADDENDUM TO THE AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION BETWEEN THE CITY
OF READING AND THE READING SCHOOL DISTRICT

This First Addendum to the Agreement of Cooperation dated _____
(hereinafter referred to as "Agreement") is made and entered into by and between the City of
Reading, a municipal corporation of the State of Pennsylvania (hereinafter referred to as "City")
and the Reading School District (hereinafter referred to as School District), with reference to the
following:

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (53 Pa. C.S. §2301 et seq.), (hereinafter
referred to as the "Act") permits municipalities (under the Act the term "municipality" includes
school district) to enter into agreements to cooperate in the exercise or performance of their
respective functions, powers or responsibilities, including recreation and parks activities; and


WHEREAS the City and School District did enter into such Agreement in an effort to provide a
mechanism to adequately and efficiently maintain community recreation services and facilities
and to organize, manage and supervise recreational and educational programs, with a primary
focus and emphasis on programs for youth, within the political boundaries of the City and the
School District; and

WHEREAS the City wishes to set forth the following clarifications to the Agreement.

ADDENDUM

1. Revenues from the parks/playgrounds will be paid to the Reading Recreation
Commission and be made a part of its revenue. Revenues from the City of Reading
Bandshell and the City of Reading Showmobile will not be made a part of the revenue of
the Reading Recreation Commission but instead will be a part of the City's revenue.
2. The City will not contribute more than \$488,000 to the Reading Recreation Commission
in a given year.
3. Both of these issues will be revisited when the Agreement expires.
4. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
5. In the event of any inconsistency between the provisions of the First Addendum and the
Agreement, the inconsistency shall be resolved by giving precedence to the documents in
the following order:
 - A. Paragraphs set forth in the body of this First Addendum.
 - B. Paragraphs set forth in the body of the Agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have caused this First Addendum to be executed by their duly authorized representatives.
