BILL NO 3 -2016

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN ALL WAY STOP INTERSECTION AT SOUTH 17th STREET AND HAAK STREET IN THE CITY OF READING, PENNSYLVANIA AS PER CITY CODE SECTION 576-213

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF READING HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The intersection of South 17th Street and Haak Street in the City of Reading, Berks County, Pennsylvania is hereby established as an all way stop intersection, in accordance with City Code Section 576-213.

SECTION TWO: Drivers of all vehicles approaching the intersection of South 17th Street and Haak Street shall come to a complete stop and not proceed into said intersection until it can be done safely, as provided in the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code, 75 Pa.C.S. § 101 et seq.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after its adoption in accordance with Sections 219 and 221 of the City of Reading Home Rule Charter.


