

RESOLUTION 31-2007

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF READING RECOGNIZING THE NEED TO IMPROVE STATE ROUTE 222 NORTH FROM ONTELAUNEE TOWNSHIP TO INTERSTATE 78:

WHEREAS, State Route 222 North from Reading to Interstate 78 is a crucial transportation artery in Berks County; and

WHEREAS, the economies of Greater Reading and Berks County depend on the speedy transfer of goods and ideas from across the Mid-Atlantic region. Adequate infrastructure is essential to making the region attractive to new business, retaining existing business and providing a competitive advantage over other regions; and


WHEREAS, State Route 222 is insufficient to meet the evolving needs of commerce and must be expanded and improved to ensure the successful long-term development of Greater Reading and Berks County.

To call upon the appropriate State and Federal officials to act towards the expansion and improvement of State Route 222, running north from Ontelaunee Township to the point where it joins with Interstate 78.


