

RESOLUTION NO. 74 -2010

AUTHORIZING THE REQUEST FOR FLASHING ELECTRONIC WARNING DEVICES TO BE INSTALLED AT SOUTH FIFTH AND BINGAMAN STREETS, AS REQUIRED BY PENNDOT.

WHEREAS, Sections 1105 and 1110 of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code requires the approval of the PA Secretary of Transportation before any traffic control device may be legally erected; and

WHEREAS, such approval is conditioned, in part, by the adoption of a Resolution by the City of Reading City Council requesting and authorizing the specific installation of flashing warning devices.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF READING HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Requesting that flashing warning devices be installed at the above-mentioned location, subject to the approval of the PA Secretary of Transportation, and that his approval is hereby requested, and

SECTION TWO. That, in the event a permit for these devices is approved after proper investigation by the PA Secretary of Transportation or his agent, the City of Reading will be bound by the following provisions:

- A. The installation shall be made in accordance with the requirements of the Regulations for Traffic Signs, Signals and Markings of the Department of Transportation or latest approved Department of Transportation standards, and
- B. Should future highway or traffic conditions, or legal requirements, necessitate alteration of the construction or operation, or hours of operation, or removal of the flashing warning devices at the above mentioned location, their removal shall be considered by the City of Reading City Council as requested by the PA Secretary of Transportation.
