


RESOLUTION NO. 160 2011


THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF READING HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:



DECLARATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: on or about September 8, 2011 a flood has caused or threatens to
to cause injury, damage, and suffering to the persons and property of
the City of Reading; and

WHEREAS: the flood has endangered the health, safety and welfare of a
substantial number of persons residing in the City of Reading,
and threatens to create problems greater in scope than the City of
Reading may be able to resolve; and

WHEREAS: Emergency Management measures are required to reduce the
severity of this disaster and to protect the health, safety, and
welfare of affected residents of the City of Reading.

Now, Therefore, I hereby declare an emergency in the City of Reading and direct all city
departments to initiate emergency measures to protect individuals and property.

This Emergency Declaration shall take effect immediately.
