**RESOLUTION FOR ADOPTION FINAL ACT 537 PLAN SPECIAL STUDY**


**WHEREAS**, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act, as Amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Pennsylvania Code, require the City of Reading ("City") to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of water and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to determine whether the proposed method of sewage disposal conforms to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management; and

**WHEREAS**, Hazen and Sawyer in conjunction with the SSM Group, Inc., has prepared an Act 537 Plan Special Study, dated August 24, 2012 (the "Act 537 Special Study"), which provides a limited analysis of the City's sewage disposal methods; and


