

THE READING WATER AUTHORITY AND UGI UTILITIES


NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF READING CITY COUNCIL HEREBY



EXHIBIT A

Cost Sharing Agreement

**WALNUT STREET RESTORATION –
NORTH 2ND STREET TO NORTH FRONT STREET
CITY OF READING, UGI UTILITIES AND READING AREA WATER AUTHORITY**

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 14th day of August, 2012, by and between

THE CITY OF READING, a municipal corporation with its principal office located at 815 Washington Street, Reading, Pennsylvania, party of the first part, hereinafter called "City", and

THE READING AREA WATER AUTHORITY, a quasi-municipal corporation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, with its principal office located at 815 Washington Street, Reading, Pennsylvania, party of the second part, hereinafter called "Authority", and UGI Utilities, 2525 North 12th Street, Suite 360, Reading, Pennsylvania.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the City proposes to restore the paving, curb, and sidewalk along Walnut Street between North 2nd Street and North Front Street, resulting from modifications to utilities.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto, in consideration of the preamble and undertaking thereof, and intended to be legally bound, hereby agree as follows:


1. The Authority will prepare the plans and specifications for the restoration of Walnut Street, including the replacement of the handicapped ramps at the intersection of Walnut and Pear Streets. The plans and specifications will be prepared to meet the requirements of the City and PennDOT.
2. The Authority will obtain the required PennDOT Highway Occupancy Permit for the work.
3. The documents will be bid in two separate parts:
 - a. Part 1: Work in the intersection of Pear and Walnut Streets, as noted in Attachment A; and
 - b. Part 2: The remaining work east and west of Part 1, as noted in Attachment A.
4. The Authority will solicit bids for the restoration of Walnut Street, in accordance with the Public Bidding law and the Authority's Act. All bids received by the Authority will be submitted to the City for review and approval.
5. The Authority will administer the Contract through closeout and will provide field inspection.


6. The Authority will be fully responsible for the payment of all costs associated with Part 1.
7. The City and UGI will be responsible for payment of all costs associated with Part 2 as noted on Exhibit A.
8. The base paving installed in the north lane of Walnut Street in the intersection of Walnut Street and Pear Street as noted on drawing no. 100 has been installed by the City of Reading. The City of Reading will be given a credit for this work, based on the cost as noted on the Contractors invoice for this work.
9. All payment requests pertaining to Part 1 will be reviewed by the Authority.
10. All payment requests pertaining to Part 2 will be reviewed by the City and UGI.
11. Within 30 days from the date of approval by the City and UGI, the City and UGI will remit any payment required for the work performed on behalf of the City and UGI in conjunction with Part 2, to the Authority.
12. This Agreement shall be dated the date of the last execution by the parties hereto.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have caused this Agreement to be executed by their proper corporate officers as and for the respective act and deed of the said corporations, each intending to be legally bound hereby and to bind their respective successors and assigns.






