
A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF READING SUPPORTING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, FOR THE DESIGNATION OF A KEYSTONE COMMUNITIES ENTERPRISE ZONE AND AMENDING RESOLUTION 80-2013, by adding the words "commercial properties".

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Reading supports the filing of an application securing Keystone Communities Enterprise Zone designation from the Department of Community and Economic Development of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, which would encompass certain industrial and manufacturing areas and commercial properties within the City of Reading; and

WHEREAS the City of Reading is willing to participate in the implementation of a Five-Year Business Development Strategy; and

WHEREAS the City of Reading authorizes the Greater Berks Development Fund to prepare and submit said application for designation and to represent the City in the implementation of the Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that President of Council is directed to execute this Resolution and to furnish a copy hereof to the Department of Community and Economic Development.


