

RESOLUTION NO. 19 2015

City Council hereby resolves the following to contain the overall costs of the Waste Water Treatment Plant project:

1. The Waste Water Treatment Plant project has cost the City of Reading millions of dollars to date under the watchful oversight of the Department of Justice.
2. City Council is committed to building a quality facility at the same time protecting ratepayers across the region from any and all unnecessary expenses and costs.


City Council hereby further resolves:


3. Any contract for the Waste Water Treatment Plant project will be awarded by Council based on an open contracting bidding process OR a dual bidding process. Any contracts that were obtained outside of this open contracting or Dual bidding processes will not be considered by City Council for approval.


The open contracting bidding process and dual bidding process are defined as follows:

- a. A open contracting bidding process that has no exclusion of any possible bidders due to exclusionary requirements including but not limited to provisions related to or represented of a Project Labor Agreement; and/or any other requirement(s) that could exclude any potential bidder
- b. A dual bidding process that allows for bidders to respond to RFP's without any exclusionary requirements requiring or representative of a project labor agreement or other exclusionary requirements (as defined in "a" directly above) AND a separate RFP with exclusionary requirements for bidders who may want to bid with those requirements attached.
