City of Reading to Host Series of Fair Housing Meetings for Landlords and Property Managers

The City of Reading cordially invites all landlords and property managers to attend a discussion on fair housing, property maintenance, and investing in the City. There are three scheduled meetings on February 25, 13:00 – 15:00 at Pandora Park Field House; March 11, 13:00-15:00 at Schlegel Park Field House; and March 25, 13:00-15:00 at Keffer Park Field House.

These meetings will work to address these issues by providing learning opportunities for landlords and property managers to create a greater awareness of services available to all our constituents. Topics include an overview of the Fair Housing Act and how to avoid potential violations, a walkthrough of the process of becoming a landlord or property manager, and a discussion on landlord/tenant relationships, the importance of a solid lease, and apartment maintenance.

Tenants will be invited to the next set of discussions.

It is the hope that through these meetings and conversations, all parties involved can work together to improve the standard of housing in the City for all constituents.
