- Hampden Blvd & Perry Sts. (NE corner)
- Forrest St. at Pandora Park (Parking Lot entrance at Forrest)
- City Park (At lot near basketball/tennis courts)
- Centre Park (On South side of Douglass between Centre Ave. and 4th St.)
- Keffer Park (On Exeter St. between Centre Ave. and N 4th St. on street in front of green concession stand at ball field)
- Weiser and Oley Sts. on Oley (Northeast side right at corner)
- 3rd and Spring Playground (East side of 3rd St. between Spring and Robeson Sts.)
