### FIFTH STREET FROM ROBESON STREET TO LAUREL STREET

In conjunction with PennDOT's safety improvements to Fifth Street, City Council adopted an ordinance on April 11 removing 17 parking spaces on North Fifth Street at the intersections of Oley, Woodward and Douglass Streets to increase time to see and react to approaching traffic at these intersection.

Public Works crews will be doing the work to remove the spaces. The exact location of parking restrictions can be seen on the plans provided by PennDOT that are available for viewing in City Hall.

We anticipate construction to begin this summer. We hope this advanced notice allows you to prepare for and adjust to these changes.
